

Edit Resolver

Use the following method to edit a resolver:

```
PUT /settings/nameservers/:id.xml
PUT /settings/nameservers/:id.json
```

XML Request example

```
curl -i -X PUT -H 'Accept: application/xml' -H 'Content-type: application/xml' -u user:userpass -d
'<nameserver><address>128.123.123.123</address><network_id>3</network_id></nameserver>' --url http://onapp.test
/settings/nameservers/:id.xml
```

JSON Request example

```
curl -i -X PUT -H 'Accept: application/json' -H 'Content-type: application/json' -u user:userpass -d
'{"nameserver":{"address":"129.123.123.123","network_id":"6"}}' --url http://onapp.test/settings/nameservers/:
id.json
```

You can edit the address and network_id parameters.
